



Busy Bees Quilt Guild Minutes - 8 August 2018

Hospitality from 10:00 to 10:25

Meeting called to order at 10:25 am by President Sheila Barhorst

Opening remarks by Sheila

- Greeted members and guests.
- Thanked Mona for filling in during her absence last month.
- Thanked Tony Figurilli for his stint as auctioneer for the July 2018 auction.
- Greeted guest speaker Cheryl Keith.
- Reminded members to turn off cell phones.

Standing Activities:

 - Marilyn Cooper reminded new members to see her for a new member packet which includes bylaws and constitution and nametag pattern.
 - Marilyn also asked that recent new members see her or Linda Harkins to get their photo taken which will be included in the directory book located at the check in table.
- Sheila reminded us that yearly membership dues are \$20 per year, with pro-rated dues of \$10 for members joining from July and later.
- Mentioned individuals who should be kept in thoughts and prayers.
- **Secretary Report:** Asked if any additions or changes to the Secretary report as published in the newsletter. None. Asked for motion to accept report as published. Motion by Jeanette Cummings, second by Donna Estabrooks. Vote: motion passed.
- **Treasurer Report - Deb Wells** reported: Beginning Balance on June 1, 2018 was \$8995.84. Income and expenses were noted. Ending Balance on June 30, 2018 was \$8760.59. Report filed for audit.

- **Nominating Committee: Deb Wells** reported that the committee was actively seeking volunteers for the upcoming open board positions and committee chairs. Members of the nominating committee are Deb, Dot Wilson, Maxine Ensor, Sandy Nodes and Joan Derylak. Deb circulated a list of current open positions including names of those who have so far agreed to be nominated. She asked that any member desiring to serve on the board or as a chair or co-chair of a committee to sign up. Someone from the nominating committee will get in touch to answer questions and provide further descriptions of the role. Deb restated the positions where volunteers are needed:
